

Iran: Deeds Over Declarations

Prof. Kobi Michael argues that Iran's actions are more significant than its declarations, as the regime uses strategic narratives to deter international pressure and serve its own interests.

He emphasizes that the international community must prevent Iran from acquiring nuclear and ballistic capabilities while stopping its support for regional proxies that cause instability.

Furthermore, he suggests that regional stabilization will only be achieved through an effective blockade and military pressure that paralyzes the regime's control.
