

Israeli-American Strategy and the Iranian Nuclear Threat

Prof. Kobi Michael analyzes the strategic dynamics between Israel and the U.S. regarding the Iranian nuclear threat, asserting that Israel may act independently if any future agreement allows Iran to retain enriched uranium or remain a regional threat.

He maintains that “waging peace” with the current Iranian regime is impossible and insists that the total removal of all enriched uranium and full facility inspections are non-negotiable prerequisites to prevent Iran from obtaining a nuclear bomb as “policy insurance” for its survival.
