Prof. Kobi Michael analyzes the geopolitical dynamics between the US, Israel, and Iran, explaining that US reluctance to resume military strikes stems from domestic constraints and diplomatic goals rather than ammunition shortages.

He also emphasizes that a vast majority of Israelis view Iran as their primary existential threat and are prepared to take independent military action to weaken its capabilities and regional proxies.
