

Nuclear Negotiations, US-Israel Relations, and Regional Conflict

Prof. Kobi Michael expresses skepticism regarding a potential nuclear agreement between the U.S. and Iran, citing internal Iranian factions and predicting a higher probability of a resumed military campaign over successful negotiations.

He also addresses the tensions in Israel-U.S. relations and defends Israeli military actions in Lebanon, arguing that Hezbollah's use of civilian infrastructure like hospitals as human shields renders them legitimate military targets under international law.
