Prof. Kobi Michael expresses skepticism regarding Pakistan's role as a mediator between the U.S. and Iran, arguing that Pakistan is driven by its own domestic interests and regional commitments rather than a desire for peace or stability.

He further cautions that the United States should rethink its relationship with Pakistan, noting that the U.S. has failed to learn from past instances where Pakistan's actions contradicted American interests, such as during the hunt for Osama bin Laden.
