

Strategic Limbo: Breaking the Iranian Axis

Prof. Kobi Michael argues that Israel is currently in a “strategic limbo” and must reshape the regional architecture by dismantling Hamas and Hezbollah to effectively weaken the Iranian regime.

He further characterizes the conflict as a defense of Western civilization against radicalism, warning that Iran uses “false diplomacy” as a deceptive tactic to gain time and rebuild its strength.
