Prof. Kobi Michael expresses skepticism regarding the success of the current 60-day negotiation period, arguing that Iran is not an honest partner and that significant gaps remain between the two sides.

He emphasizes the need for dismantling the Fordo enrichment facility, implementing robust monitoring, and ensuring that any economic relief is strictly conditional on Iranian performance.
