Prof. Kobi Michael discusses Israel's disapproval of the MOU, emphasizing that Israel remains skeptical of the 60-day negotiation and is prepared to resume military action against threats in Lebanon and Iran.

He also highlights the friction in the U.S.-Israel alliance caused by diverging interests regarding Iran, while maintaining that both countries still share a fundamental commitment to preventing a nuclear-armed Iran.
