Prof. Kobi Michael argues that reports regarding US-Iran negotiations are often tools of psychological warfare and that the fundamental gaps between the two sides remain unbridgeable.

He suggests that while President Trump's contradictory statements aim to pressure and confuse Iran, the lack of actual progress on core demands makes military escalation more probable than a signed agreement.
