Ruth Wasserman Lande argues that Iran is an unreliable partner that cannot be trusted to uphold any agreement, meaning that the lack of a nuclear deal is not necessarily a bad outcome for Israel.

She also suggests that the United States is strategically choosing to “wait out” the situation to avoid cornering a dangerous Iranian regime, preferably delaying major actions until after the midterm elections.
