

Philadelphi issue strains Israel-Egypt bilateral relations

Reporter Mark Weiss spoke with Ruth Wasserman Lande about the question over the security arrangements for the Philadelphi corridor, the 14-kilometer route along the Egypt-Gaza border, has increased tension between Israel and Egypt. Cairo is demanding the IDF's immediate withdrawal from the Rafah terminal and from the Philadelphi Corridor.
